The Food Division places top priority on delivering safe and quality products.

For marine products, we ensure both quality and safety, while building up solid partnerships with key suppliers within Japan, Asia, and South America. Our mainstay, which is seafood for sushi is delivered to restaurant chains and mass merchandisers through a distribution system jointly operated with affiliates.

For agricultural products, we procure frozen blueberries and other frozen fruits and various fruit juices from around the globe. These fruits and juices are then marketed for a broad range of uses, such as in jams, yogurt, jelly, and fruit beverages. In response to consumer needs, we also seek districts in Japan that produce vegetables for frozen products. We ensure a stable supply of quality foods, with an optimal combination of superior growers, processing, and distribution systems.

Marine Products Department
